



What to Bring to Class

- An Oklahoma Driver's License or Oklahoma Identification Card
- Baseball type cap or hat with brim or bill
- Firearm, no larger than .45 caliber.
- A gun case or bag to transport your gun
- 50 rounds NEW FACTORY Ammo (no reloads commercial or otherwise)
- Eye Protection
- Hearing Protection
- Ink pen (black ink) & paper

DO NOT bring a weapon or ammunition into the classroom, leave it secured in your vehicle. If you would like an instructor to look at it, make contact with them before class or on a break and the instructor will look at it then. Otherwise, all weapons will be inspected at the range before shoot begins.

Tips:

- A .22LR semi-auto pistol is the ideal weapon to bring to the class.
- Expect a full 8 hours of class, 4 hours in the classroom and 4 hours on the range. You will get what you pay for and I am not one for cutting corners when it comes to carrying a firearm.
- Try to arrive a few minutes early to class for any last minute questions for the instructor.
- If you cannot attend the class please let us know 48 hours prior to class so your seat can be filled.
